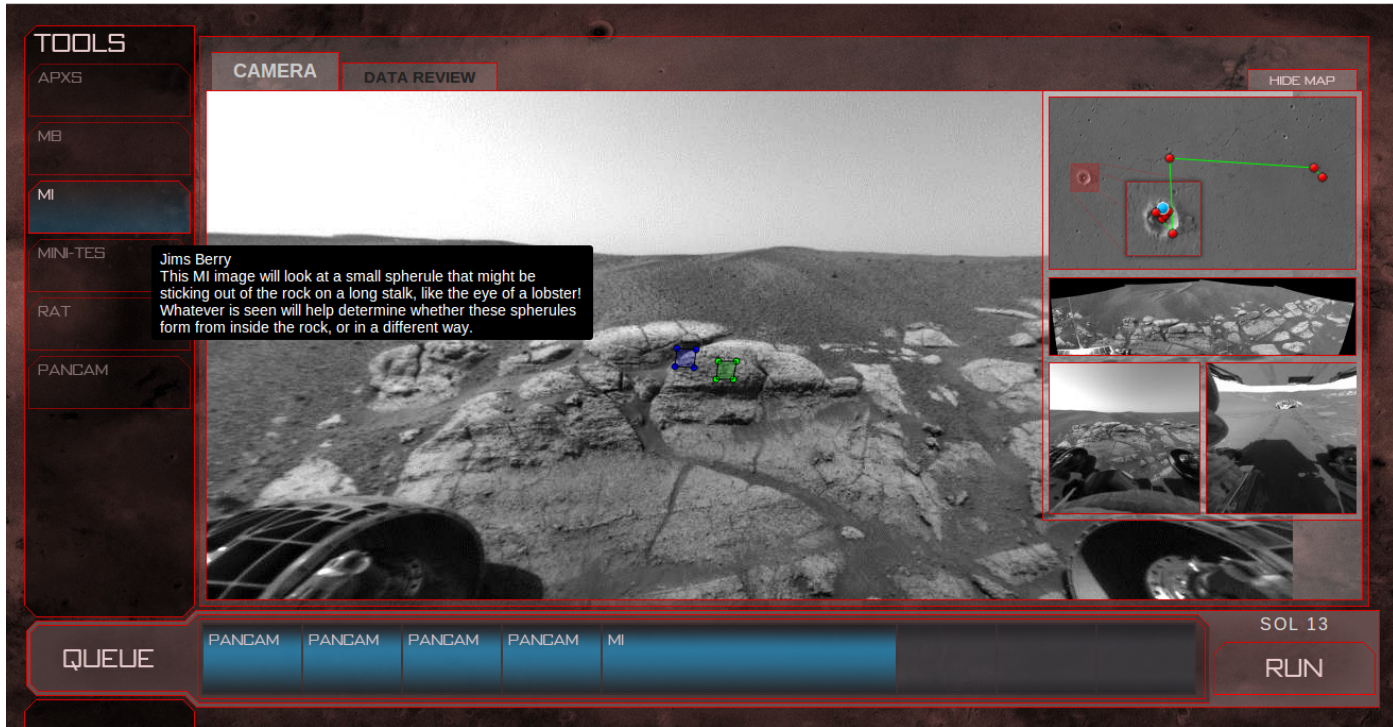


The Extraterrestrial Field Experience (EVFE)!
