- For other support, purchases may be made by NYSG on your behalf, or reimbursed to you.
- Funds cannot be transferred for your future use.
- You must provide a written summary of the project/activity funded, and complete an awardee form to document demographic & academic information.
- Depending on the nature of support provided, other paperwork may be required.
